Scholarships: Scholarships are available to those who qualify. Please call our main office at (360) 385-5582 for details.

Deposits, Final Payment, and Cancellation Policy: Deposits are due with registration. Final payment for camp tuition is due by June 15th. Cancellations received or postmarked by May 15th will have their deposit refunded less \$75. For Junior Explorers the non-refundable portion of the deposit is \$50. There will be no refund for cancellations received after June 15th.

Ages: Campers for the Marine Biology Day Camp *must* be between the ages of 9 and 13 by the first day of camp. Campers for the Coastal Explorers Day Camp *must* be between the ages of 8 and 12 by the first day of camp. Junior Explorers *must* be between the ages of 5 and 7 by the first day of camp. Campers for Longboard Explorers *must* be between the ages of 12 and 18 by the first day of camp.

Drop Off & Pick Up: Coastal Explorers and Marine Biology Day Camps start at 9am on Monday and end at 4pm each day at PTMSC at Fort Worden, except for the Junior Explorers which are Monday thru Friday 9am to Noon or 1pm to 4pm. The Longboat Explorers camps start at PTMSC both days, and end at PTMSC the first day, then Northwest Maritime Center the second day (431 Water St. in Port Townsend).

Activity Level: Our camps are moderately demanding. We hike an average of three miles a day and are usually found at the water's edge or in the water up to knee level. Junior Explorers hike an average of 1-2 miles. **We reserve the right to refuse space to anyone we feel might not be comfortable with our program.**
