**Deposits:** Deposits are due with registration.

**Final Payment:** Final payment for camp tuition is due by June 15th.

**Cancellation Policy:** Cancellations received or postmarked by May 15th will have their deposit refunded less \$75. For Junior Explorers the non-refundable portion of the deposit is \$50. There will be no refund for cancellations received after June 15th.

**Ages:** Campers for the Marine Biology Day Camp **must** be between the ages of 9 and 13 by the first day of camp. Campers for the Coastal Explorers Day Camp **must** be between the ages of 8 and 12 by the first day of camp. Junior Explorers **must** be between the ages of 5 & 7 by the first day of camp.

**Drop off & Pick up:** Day camps start at 9 AM on Monday and end at 4 PM each day, except for the Junior Explorers which are Monday thru Friday 9 AM to 12 PM. Campers must arrive and be picked up on time.

**Activity level:** Our camps are moderately demanding. We hike an average of three miles a day and are usually found at the water's edge or in the water up to knee level. **We reserve the right to refuse space to anyone we feel might not be comfortable with our program.**
